**Mrs. Melania Trump,

We are Venezuelan mothers whose children have been separated from our arms. They have been kept under painful circumstances on U.S. territory as a consequence of migrant deportation policies, policies that have broken entire families, leaving little ones to live in uncertainty and exposed to a reality they cannot fully understand.

Can you be at peace for even a minute without knowing the whereabouts of your child? Could you sleep calmly without knowing if they ate or how they are feeling? We cannot move forward without having them near us.

Today, we raise our voices in the name of our families, of maternal love, and of human rights, to request your attention to a tragedy hidden behind the political display against migrants in U.S. territory. This policy does not allow families to be reunited.

We are women of faith, and we belong to working families; now, all we wish to do is see our children again. Children are being denied the right to grow up in love. Children's rights are above any political decision.

Mrs. Melania, you are a mother, and you have publicly advocated for the well-being of children around the world. We ask you, as mothers, to raise your voices, to help our children return to their homes, to be a bridge for the justice and humanity that you invoke. We ask you to hear the cry of the families, that this policy of separation may no longer continue, that mothers simply be deported together with their children.

With faith that you can still influence to create happy endings and stop this suffering for our children, we say goodbye with profound hope. **Free our children.**
